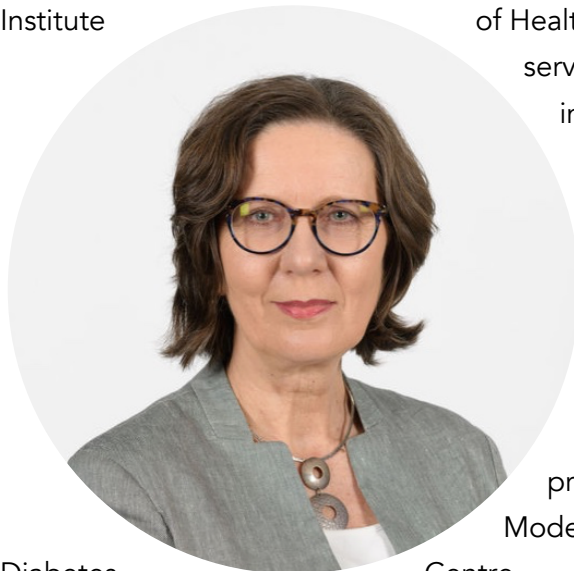

Using novel co-design approaches and multi-method studies she has led evaluations of complex integrated care interventions for children and adults living with chronic and complex disease. She often works as an embedded researcher with large interdisciplinary teams across many health settings - mental health, primary care, ED, hospital and ICU. She leads the Models of Care Stream of the Rio Tinto Children's
