

The ASITI-201 Study

(Type 1 Diabetes clinical trial)

Join us in testing a new treatment for Type 1 Diabetes.

The Princess Alexandra Hospital and the University of Queensland are testing a new medication (ASITI-201) for Type 1 Diabetes in a clinical trial.

ASITI-201 is made of small lipid particles containing proteins combined with a form of vitamin D, designed to reprogram the immune system in diabetes.

The trial aims to find out:

- If ASITI-201 is safe
- If ASITI-201 helps stop the immune system from attacking insulin-producing cells in the pancreas, which occurs in Type 1 Diabetes
- What is the best dose to use

You may be eligible if you:

- Are aged 18-55
- Were diagnosed with Type 1 Diabetes within the last 5 years

Study activities are undertaken at the Princess Alexandra Hospital and participants need to attend in person.
